# **What Does MoTA Offer?**



### ✓ Governmental Relations

With the multitude of issues facing the trucking industry and business in general, a strong voice in the Missouri Capitol is needed. The lobbying efforts of the Association include direct contact with legislators, as well as legislative bulletins to the membership. Activities also include contact with various state agencies with regard to procedures, rules and regulations.

#### ✓ Information and Public Relations

Newsletters and emails containing the latest information available on trends developing in the industry keep members informed. With the constant changes taking place in rules, regulations, and laws, information is not a luxury, it is a necessity. The Association also provides the economic importance of trucking and other industry data to the public and news media.

#### ✓ Personal Service

The Association employs four full-time employees to assist members as needed. The staff has great professional relationships with the Missouri State Highway Patrol, Missouri Department of Transportation, Missouri Department of Revenue, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and Federal Highway Administration.

# Safety Programs

The Association safety programs include Driver of the Month, Driver of the Year, Safety Director of the Year, fleet safety contests and the Chair's Safe Driver Club. The Council of Safety Supervisors includes safety experts from MoTA member companies who meet monthly and host several events including a Safety Conference, Safety Day at Rest Stops, Truck Driving Championships Competition, Driver Appreciation Event and Weigh Station Visits. The winners of DOY and TDC compete nationally for honors!

# ✓ Technology & Maintenance Programs

The Technology and Maintenance Council is comprised of maintenance experts from MoTA member companies who meet throughout the year. TMC programs include a "SuperTech" skills competition which is a hands-on challenge with multiple skills stations. Technicians test their skills and learn new skills! The winner advances to compete nationally.

# ✓ Leadership Programs

The Association provides a leadership development program called the Missouri Trucking Leadership Forum. It is an 8-session, 2-year program led by the CEO of a Missouri trucking company. The MTLF is designed to expose managers to leadership skills that build competency.
